## **GENERAL UNDERTAKINGS AND CONDITIONS.**

All riders, teams' personnel and all the persons involved in any capacity whatsoever participating in the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy undertake, on behalf of themselves, their employees, and agents, to observe all the provisions of:

1. SPORTING REGULATIONS
2. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS
3. BMW Motorrad Race Trophy Conditions of Entry

as supplemented and amended from time to time.

Whilst these Regulations may be translated into other languages, in case of any dispute regarding interpretation the Official English text will prevail.

It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure that all persons concerned with its entry observe all the requirements of the Regulations of the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy.

## **AMENDMENTS TO THE BMW Motorrad Race Trophy Regulations (HEREINAFTER COLLECTIVELY REFERRED to as "REGULATIONS").**

BMW Motorrad Motorsport may at any time amend any or all provisions of the Regulations.

Any subsequent changes that take place after the printed versions are completed on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 will be made electronically, and the online versions would then be the prevailing version. The amendments become effective if the entrants do not object in writing to

Entrants who object to the amendments are disqualified from the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy 2017.

# 1. SPORTING REGULATIONS.

## 1.1. RACING SERIES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS.

The BMW Motorrad Race Trophy 2017 (hereinafter collectively referred to as “Race Trophy”) consists of 27 championship classes within 20 racing series:

**BMW Combined Road Race Challenge.**

Explanation:

The official championships will be completed by the so called „BMW Combined Road Race Challenge“, which is a fusion of the following official Road Race Championships:

- North West 200 (Superstock & Superbike Races)
- Isle of Man TT (Superstock, Superbike & Senior TT Race)
- Southern 100 (Senior & Solo Championship Race)
- Ulster Grand Prix (Superstock & Superbike Races)
- Macau Grand Prix (Superbike Race)

The „BMW Combined Road Race Challenge“ shall be deemed as a championship compared to the official championships with the **same system** of Race points, Extra points and rankings within the Race Trophy.

In the BMW Combined Road Race Challenge the individual race results in Superbike, Superstock and Open classes will be counted all together, which leads to one overall championship class.

REGISTRATION.

## **1.2. RACE TROPHY SEASON.**

Race Trophy season 2017: 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 – 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2017

Racing events held after 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 won't be considered in any **current and future** ranking of the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy 2017 (except EWC, see article 1.7.1).

## **1.3. ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS.**

### **1.3.1. RACING LICENCE.**

Riders must be in possession of an adequate **valid** national or international motorcycle racing licence for the 2017 season, which is valid for the individual championship from article 1.1.

### **1.3.2. REGISTRATION.**

Riders must be in possession of a **valid and confirmed** registration for the Race Trophy 2017 season.

## **1.4. REGISTRATION.**

### **1.4.1. VALIDITY.**

Riders must submit a valid registration until **30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017**, whether or not they have already participated in the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy.

BMW Motorrad Motorsport reserves the right to accept later registrations.

### **1.4.2. COMPULSORY STATEMENTS.**

Each registration specifies the following mandatory details:

- gender,
- full name (first and last name),
- date of birth,
- nationality,
- post address (street, street no., postcode, city and country),
- valid telephone number (including country code),
- valid email address, and
- name of at least one eligible championship.

### **1.4.3. FURTHER REQUIREMENTS.**

With its registration riders confirm that they have read, understood and accepted the Regulations of the BMW Motorrad Race Trophy 2017 and the Conditions of Entry, which are provided under article 3 of the Regulations.

### **1.4.4. COMPLETENESS OF THE REGISTRATION.**

Only if all mandatory points from article 1.4.2 are fulfilled, the registration is valid and the rider will receive a **registration confirmation**. Only then the rider will be listed in each future standings. Otherwise the rider is not eligible for the Race Trophy and won't be considered in any ranking.

## RACE TROPHY POINTS.

### 1.4.5. EXCLUSION CRITERIA.

Riders without evidence of participation in racing events within one eligible championship, until the 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, will be excluded from the Race Trophy.

Riders who change to another motorcycle manufacturer during the Race Trophy season will be excluded from the Race Trophy with immediate effect (Exception: participation in several eligible championships).

## 1.5. RACE TROPHY POINTS.

### 1.5.1. OVERVIEW.

Riders must compete in one eligible championship from article 1.1.

Race Trophy points consist of the following points:

**RACE POINTS**, and

**EXTRA POINTS**, comprising:

**Championship** points,

**Pole** points, and

**Sticker** points

### 1.5.2. COMBINED CLASSES.

Combined classes (Superbike with Superstock), although competing in the same races, will be scored in their respective class and therefore will not be eligible to cross enter into another class in the same race.

### 1.5.3. MAXIMUM SCORE.

The maximum score is **500.00 BMW Motorrad Race Trophy points**, which is split into **400.00 Race points** and **100.00 Extra points**.

### 1.5.4. RACE TROPHY POINTS.

Race Trophy points are those gained in the **best** eligible championship. It is not possible to mix Race points with Extra points from different championships. They already consider Throw Outs (see article 1.6).

### 1.5.5. RATED TRACK SESSIONS.

The minimum numbers for any calculation will always be **eight races**, regardless whether riders participate in less races.

The only exception to this rule is the Endurance World Championship (see article 1.7).

### 1.5.6. RACE POINTS.

**Race points** are those gained in each rated race within the **best** championship of a rider.

Riders may score a maximum of **400.00 Race points** over the Race Trophy season, **regardless** the championship and the number of rated races.



## RACE TROPHY POINTS.

### 1.5.7. RATED RACES.

Rated races are the total number of races with official results within **one** championship minus the appropriate number of Throw Outs, depending on the championship.

### 1.5.8. MINIMUM NUMBER OF RACE STARTERS.

Requirement to reach the maximum of 400.00 Race points is a race starting field with a minimum of **12 starters** in each class and race.

If the race starting field consists of **less** than 12 starters, the Race points for the appropriate race/s will be multiplied with the following formula:

$$\text{race starters} / 12 * \text{Race points}$$

### 1.5.9. RACE POINTS PER RACE.

1 <sup>st</sup>	400.00points / rated races
2 <sup>nd</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 80%
3 <sup>rd</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 64%
4 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 52%
5 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 44%
6 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 40%
7 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 36%
8 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 32%
9 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 28%
10 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 24%
11 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 20%
12 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 16%
13 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 12%
14 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 8%
≥15 <sup>th</sup>	400.00points / rated races * 4%

The only exception to this calculation is the Endurance World Championship. This special calculation can be found under article 1.7 (Specifics).

### 1.5.10. RACE INTERRUPTIONS.

Shortened or interrupted races, which cannot be resumed, will be rated for the Race Trophy **only** if the race results are awarded with **full** championship points by the appropriate race organizer.

### 1.5.11. EXTRA POINTS.

Extra points are awarded for winning one of the listed championship classes, taking pole positions in rated qualifying and displaying the official "BMW Motorrad Motorsport" stickers compliant to rules (see article 2).

### 1.5.12. CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS.

**Championship points** are those gained for winning a championship (see article 1.1).

Riders may score either **40.00** Championship points or **0**.

## RACE TROPHY POINTS.

If for any reason a championship takes **longer** than the Race Trophy season, riders who are listed first within their appropriate championship on **19<sup>th</sup> November, 2017** will receive Championship points.

### 1.5.13. POLE POINTS.

**Pole points** are those gained in each **rated** qualifying within the best championship, if riders take the **pole position** within their classes.

If more than one rider is listed on one and the same racing bike (Endurance World Championship) **only** the rider will receive Pole points, who officially scored the fastest lap time in the appropriate qualifying.

Riders may score a maximum of **30.00** Pole points over the Race Trophy season, **regardless** the championship and the number of rated qualifying.

### 1.5.14. RATED QUALIFYINGS.

Rated qualifying are the total number of qualifying with official results, **only** within the appropriate championship minus the appropriate number of Throw Outs, depending on the championship.

### 1.5.15. POLE POINTS PER QUALIFYING.

The maximum of 30.00 Pole points will be divided by the number of **rated qualifying** within the best championship on the following formula (with full starting field):

Pole points per qualifying = 30.00 points / rated qualifying

### 1.5.16. STICKER POINTS.

**Sticker points** are those gained for displaying the official "BMW Motorrad Motorsport" stickers, unaltered and in the specified areas, during any official on track sessions (see article 2.2).

### 1.5.17. SCORE OF STICKER POINTS.

Riders may score a maximum of **30.00** Sticker points over the Race Trophy season, which are divided by the number of **rated races** within the best championship on the following formula:

Sticker points per race = 30.00 points / rated races

In case of **uncertainty** and on **request** the burden of proof is **with the rider**.

### 1.5.18. DELIVERY OF STICKERS.

After riders have subscribed with a valid registration (see article 1.4) they will receive the vector graphic of the official "BMW Motorrad Motorsport" stickers by e-mail as well as a tracked parcel to the given address.

If riders will produce the stickers themselves, the stickers must match in size and colour with the original ones (see article 2.3).

THROW OUTS.

## 1.6. THROW OUTS.

**Throw Outs** are poor race results or qualifying results of a rider during the Race Trophy season, which are **not** counted in the ranking of the Race Trophy (hereinafter collectively referred to “Throw Out **Races**” and “Throw Out **Qualifyings**”).

Depending on the championship, the numbers of Throw Outs are given and **mandatory**.

### 1.6.1. THROW OUT RACES.

## SPECIFICS.

### 1.7. SPECIFICS.

#### 1.7.1. ENDURANCE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP.

The Race Trophy 2017 consists of following Endurance Races:

- 24 Heures Motos Le Mans
- 8 Hours Oschersleben
- 8 Hours of Slovakia Ring
- Suzuka 8 Hours

The lengths of the races within the Endurance World Championships are either 8h or 24h.

#### 1.7.2. RACE POINTS FOR 8H RACES.

After the end of 8h races riders will be awarded with the following amounts of points:

#### 1.7.3. RACE POINTS FOR 24H RACES.

24h races will be counted as **three 8h races**. After 8 hours, after 16 hours as well as after 24 hours riders will be awarded with points (see article 1.7.2).

If for any reason the number or lengths of races change, the Race points will be adapted so that the maximum score of all endurance races will **never exceed** 400.00 Race points.

#### 1.7.4. TIED STANDINGS.

In the final BMW Motorrad Race Trophy ranking, EWC riders with identical Race Trophy points, will be awarded as one rider and will receive the prize money for the ranked (single) position. Cash prizes for the relevant position are divided by the number of riders and paid out to the riders concerned in **equal** amounts.

## 1.8. STANDINGS, CASH PRIZES AND AWARDS.

### 1.8.1. WINNER BMW MOTORRAD RACE TROPHY.

The winner of the Race Trophy shall be the rider amassing the **highest number** of Race Trophy points over the Race Trophy season.

### 1.8.2. PUBLICATION OF STANDINGS.

The standings of the Race Trophy will be updated **once** a week.

### 1.8.3. FINAL STANDINGS.

The final standings will be published after the assessment period of the Race Trophy season 2017 and will include all achieved Race points, Championship points, Pole points and Sticker points.

### 1.8.4. TIED STANDINGS.

In the event of a tie in the standings, the riders concerned are ranked with the same position. In case of a tie in the final standings, the relevant cash prizes are added together and paid out to the riders concerned in **equal** amounts (except EWC, see article 1.7.4).

### 1.8.5. CASH PRIZES.\*

The Race Trophy will have a total prize purse of **EUR 100,000**, which will be distributed to the best **30 riders** of the final standings as follows:

## STANDINGS, CASH PRIZES AND AWARDS.

### 1.8.6. CHAMPIONSHIP BONUS FOR RIDERS.

Each rider who wins a championship (article 1.1) receives **EUR 2,500** in prize money.

### 1.8.7. CHAMPIONSHIP BONUS FOR TEAMS.

The teams of the champions from article 1.8.6 will receive **EUR 7,500** in prize money.

Teams are only eligible in **one** championship to win a cash prize.

### 1.8.8. NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR.\*

The rider participating for the very **first time** in the Race Trophy and scoring the highest Race Trophy points, but a minimum of 100,00 points, will be provided with a voucher for a BMW original parts package to the value of **EUR 2,500 gross**. The voucher can be redeemed, if the rider is participating the upcoming Race Trophy.

### 1.8.9. BEST BMW RIDER IN CLASS BONUS.\*

Riders who fulfil the following criteria, receive a bonus of **EUR 500** in prize money:

- Best BMW Rider in class
- Ranked outside Top 30 in final standings of the Race Trophy
- minimum score of 100,00 Race Trophy points after the end of the appropriate season

### 1.8.10. RACE FINISHER BONUS.

Riders who fulfil the following criteria, receive a bonus of **EUR 500** in prize money:

- finish of all rated races within the appropriate championship
- no last position in any rated race
- ranked outside Top 30 in final standings of the Race Trophy
- minimum score of 100,00 Race Trophy points after the end of the appropriate season

### 2.2. BMW MOTORRAD MOTORSPORT STICKER.

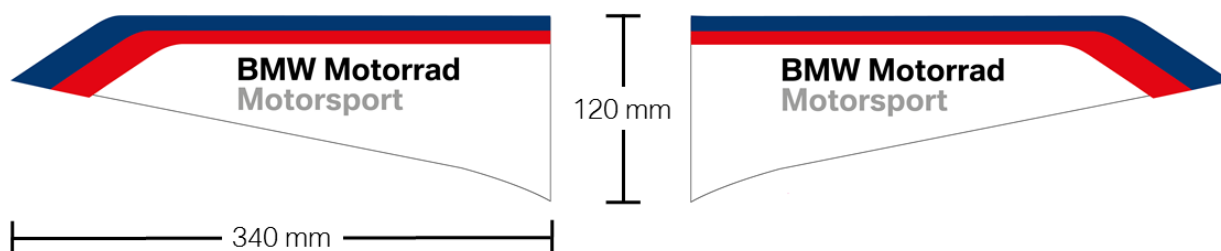
The two stickers have to be displayed unaltered and in the specified areas, during any official on track sessions on both sides of the motorcycle compliant to the following images:
